### 19 - What aspects of the course and/or Marina Duque's instructional methods could be improved that would enhance your learning? Please give examples. -

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>I feel that she could grade assignments- specifically the writing assignments- with a bit more speed.</li> <li>Receiving comments and grades on the writing assignments before the next one is due would be helpful so you could see what needs improvement and what was satisfactory.</li> <li>I found Dr. Duque's style was mostly ineffective. To be clear, I think she is extremely intelligent and as such would take a class with her again because she found a way to break down complex topics and explain them in a way which a layperson could understand - which is the mark of a great instructor. However, she attempted to make the course discussion-based, when it was clear that most students either did not do the readings or simply had no interest in responding and facilitating discussion. As such, I felt like a lot of my own understanding of the course was limited as one of the few people who actually answered questions: I was putting in more to course than I was getting out, and I don't think that's fair. I think Dr. Duque would do much better lecturing, wherein student's understanding of the course was not fundamentally linked to the ability of other students to read and understand often complex academic jargon in a field which we are not experts, and then answer questions about such reading. If Dr. Duque had simply lectured more, I think I would have felt like I was gaining more from the course.</li> <li>I felt that the writing assignments were busy work. The prompts were also continuously wordy for them only being one page essays.</li> <li>I think the guidelines could be clearer for writing assignments. I got a very bad grade on one paper because apparently I hadn't followed guidelines but I wrote it with the rubric right next to the document and really did put in that effort. For that, I got a failing grade which I didn't think was entirely fair. Also class participation could be a little more fun to engage in rather than just with a black and white slides. We're just combing through these very insightful and important papers but I can't help but to think that the class could be structured to be a bit more fun and engaging.</li> </ul>

Dr. Duque, as previously mentioned, did an excellent job at breaking down these complexities. However, if I could make one change about the course, it would have been to assign academic papers which were perhaps easier to follow. These papers were often 30-40 pages in length, which is not unreasonable itself, but the content of the course was very in-depth (which is a good thing!) and those two things in combination made preparation for class extremely difficult.</li> <li>Overall liked this class and learned a lot.</li> <li>She's a brilliant political mind and I'm happy she works for this great university.</li> </ul>
